

The GERMANY ART PRIZE is awarded annually and awarded to academically trained artists. The award is endowed with a total of 15,000 euros. In addition, the award winners are supported by exhibitions of their works, press work and support for their activities.

With works in the three art disciplines of painting, sculpture, photography/digital art, artists from Germany and around the world have the opportunity to apply with one to five works.

No topic given: For an art prize jury and the audience, it can be interesting when artists are given a difficult political topic in which artistic imagination presents solutions. But interesting topics often change quickly, so it makes sense to forego an art award topic, especially since the annual art award motto “art powers future” exists.

Does art without a topic arise out of nowhere? Might be. If no topic is given for this art prize competition, this does not mean that the applicant should not devote themselves to their own topic. There can even be several topics per artist, as up to five submissions are possible for this art competition.

The winners of the GERMANY ART PRIZE are selected by an independent jury of experts. There are generally no application restrictions (age and origin) for academically trained artists. Up-and-coming artists up to the age of 35 are financially supported by the organizer of the art award for their career start, in that the processing fee for two submitted works is waived. This art prize is therefore an adequate competition platform for young and established artists.
