Information for the press 28 works by 23 artists were nominated for the ART PRIZE GERMANY 2023/24.

78 artists from 22 countries applied for the ART PRIZE GERMANY 2023/24 (slogan: “Art powers future”) with a total of 223 works. A jury of experts nominated 28 exhibits from 23 artists from Germany and abroad. Works in the three art disciplines of painting, sculpture/object and photography/digital art could be submitted digitally via the website www.kunstpreis-deutschland.de.

The five-person jury met on November 25th, 2023 in Hanover and January 4th, 2024 in Braunschweig. Jury members Dr. Carsten Voss (art historian, Hanover), Prof. Erich Kruse (HBK Braunschweig), Bettina Breidbach (author and artist, Bremen), Thorsten Heinze (gallery owner, Berlin) and Dr. Georg Trivisas, (ex-gallery owner and artist, Hanover) viewed and dealt with the works. Dr. is the patron of the ART PRIZE GERMANY 2023/24. Prince Asfa-Wossen Asserate.

Three art prize winners from the aforementioned art disciplines will be announced at the end of February 2024. These will be honored at a celebratory event on April 6, 2024. The three art prizes endowed with “Gold Awards” will be presented at the “phaeno” museum in Wolfsburg. In addition, the creators of the works nominated by the jury will be honored.

The winning exhibits will be visible to guests in their original form, as well as all 28 nominated works on a large screen in the phaeno event room in Wolfsburg.
